USEFUL INFORMATION

The British National Party is the only hope for the preservation of our British identity, culture and the future of our nation. You can do something very special for our country while guaranteeing your place in the history of our nationalist struggle. By leaving a gift in your will to the British National Party, you enable us to continue the fight.

How a gift in your will can make a difference

We rely overwhelmingly on donations from our members to carry out our work. We don't have the backing of Big Unions or Big Business. That's one reason we're independent and able to speak our minds and represent ordinary people. By leaving a gift to the British National Party, you can allow us to be bolder in our aims, safe in the knowledge that funds will be there in the years to come.

A gift in your will could help us to plan, grow, and sustain our long-term development without compromising our ability to react quickly to unforeseen circumstances (such as snap elections).

Every gift makes a difference. Whatever the amount, your gift will help us meet the most pressing needs the future brings to the British National Party.

We are extremely grateful for any gift we receive. We make sure that anyone leaving us a legacy is remembered and honoured.

Leaving a legacy must be done either as part of creating your will or as an amendment (codicil) to an existing one. Choose from one of the options below to see what you should do to leave a gift.

I do not have a will

If you have not already made a will, we would recommend that you contact a solicitor to help you through this process. You may be entitled to free will writing services if you are disabled or over 70 years old. We can also help with writing a will. I already have a will

If you have already made a will, leaving a legacy to the British National Party is even simpler. You can add a 'Codicil Form' to your will in order to make the necessary amendment. Just click [here](#) for a copy of the form.

Below you will see three different types of legacy which should be included in any will you make. Additionally, we recommend including the paragraph at the end of this page as well, as it will make sure your final wishes are fully met.

1. Residuary legacy

What does it mean? This is a gift of the remainder or percentage of your estate after all other legacies have been made and debts cleared.

Residuary legacies are an effective way to divide the value of an estate between a number of people and causes that are important to you.

Suggested wording: "I GIVE the whole of my estate or X per cent of the residue of my estate after payment of my funeral and testamentary expenses and debts and all legacies given by this my will or any codicil hereto and all inheritance tax payable upon or by reason of my demise to my [Executor(s)/Trustees] UPON TRUST for the British National Party of PO Box 213, Wigton, Cumbria, CA7 7AL. I confirm that I am on the electoral register in the UK (excluding the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man) at the time of signing this will."

2. Pecuniary legacy

What does it mean? A gift of a fixed sum of money.

Suggested wording: “I GIVE to the British National Party of PO Box 213, Wigton, Cumbria, CA7 7AL, the sum of XX pounds [sum in words] £XX [sum in figures] free of Inheritance Tax for its general purposes and I direct that the receipt of the Treasurer for the time being shall be sufficient discharge to my [Executor(s)/Trustees]. I confirm that I am on the electoral register in the UK (excluding the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man) at the time of signing this will.”

3. Specific legacy

What does it mean? A particular named item left as a gift in your will is known as a specific legacy, for example, a piece of jewellery.

Suggested wording: “I GIVE to the British National Party of PO Box 213, Wigton, Cumbria, CA7 7AL, for its general purposes free of Inheritance Tax and other fiscal impositions and costs of transfer my [description of the item] for its general purposes absolutely and I direct that the receipt of the Treasurer for the time being shall be sufficient discharge to my [Executor(s)/Trustees]. I confirm that I am on the electoral register in the UK (excluding the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man) at the time of signing this will.”

Recommended Additional Paragraph

If you decide to remember the British National Party in your will we also recommend taking the following paragraph to your solicitor. It is important that the following clause is included in your will, whichever type you choose:

“If at my death any charity or organisation named as a beneficiary in this will or any Codicil hereto has changed its name, amalgamated with or transferred its assets to another body, or changed its address, then my executors shall give effect to any gift made to such charity or organisation as if it had been made (in the first case) to the body in its changed name or (in the second place) to the body which results from such amalgamation or to which such transfer has been made or (in the third case) to the organisation based at their new address.”

Ensure you are on the Electoral Register

Under UK Legislation we will only be able to receive funds left to us in a will, if that person had been on a UK electoral register during the five years before their death.

If you are one of the people who have remembered the British National Party in their will, please make sure you are also on the electoral register. Just call your Town Hall and ask to speak to the Returning Officer if you are in any doubt. You should also contact us to inform us of your bequest and provide details of your executors. We can also arrange for a senior Party member to visit you and discuss matters in confidence and act as an Executor if required.
